### Surftides on the Oregon Coast Gets a Boutique-y Makeover

The **Surftides** in Lincoln City, Oregon (about 2 hours southwest of Portland) just underwent a million-dollar makeover and has unveiled its new boutique-y, environmentally friendly look -- heart-shaped in-room jacuzzis and all.

The photos on the property's [website](#) still show the pre-reno rooms (and frankly, you can tell it was time for a bit of a facelift), but they spaces have been updated in a big way:

New guest rooms effortlessly blend modern amenities such as free wireless Internet, iPod docking stations, and 32" flat-screen televisions with vintage features such as in-room kitchenettes, private beachfront balconies, suites with fireplaces and heart-shaped Jacuzzi baths.

And the rooms -- with an updated color palette of "warm creams and vibrant oranges" -- are environmentally friendly, too! This is fo sho the only eco-conscious hotel we've heard of that also boasts the sexy heart-shaped jacuzzis.

The rooms are also outfitted with custom furniture made from locally forested wood and totally local artwork. The wall coverings are an eco-friendly cork, the lighting is energy-efficient and the carpeting is recycled. Sweet.

Also new: a totally re-done lobby with a huge fireplace and windows that overlook the ocean (where you can curl up with a book checked out from the hotel's library) and an outdoor lounge with fire pits surrounded by a tiered amphitheater.
